These 40 cents go into administration  
Breakdown...



28 cents of this go into insurance-related  
billing and collections.



12 cents of this go to all non-insurance billing  
collections, and government regulations



**20 Cents**



These 20 cents go to care. This includes all  
overhead, equipment, tests, and  
procedures.  
Breakdown...



- 4 cents for various overhead costs such as  
rent or non-medical equipment

- 4 cents for medical equipment

- 5 cents for tests

- 7 cents for procedures



These 20 cents go to trained medical staff.  
This includes doctors, nurses, pharmacists,  
and technicians and pays for their salary,  
continued education, and benefits  
packages. Breakdown...

- 5 cents go to personal taxes



- 6 cents is non-cash benefits

**5 cents go to the government. This includes taxes and fees paid by the practices, not by any of the staff.**



**5 cents go to other medical services and needs. This is a catch-all category.**
